All children have the right to an education that meets their needs and Prairie Sky School takes this to heart. We will never drag a student through 'the system', so to speak. It is in this light that all new students accepted to Prairie Sky School join us on a Three Month Trial. During this time, we will ensure we can meet your child's needs (Emotionally, Socially and Academically). At the successful end of the Three Month Trail, your child will be transferred to continuous enrolment and will be considered a PSS student until they move onto high school or withdrawal from PSS (Please see PSS Withdrawal Policy). In the event we cannot meet your child's needs, we will inform you during the trial and help create a transition plan to another program (in this event, school and activity fees along with tuition will be pro-rated and returned to your family).
